Main Responsibility:

To assist in planning and delivering a well-balanced and co-ordinated programme using the England Netball coaching syllabus as outlined in the coach resource 'The Game Plan'

Duties:

- Attend training sessions and any related Academy events
- Support the Head Coach in delivering training sessions
- Contribute to a professional, friendly atmosphere ensuring all those taking part are properly guided and supervised
- Carry out pre-activity checks at the start of each session to ensure the venue, equipment and activity are safe and free of hazards
- Ensure any required administration is completed, including records of attendance, player emergency contacts and where applicable Accident/Incident Record Forms
- Undertake relevant training courses as appropriate
- Inform the Head Coach if you cannot attend training or other necessary event
- Ensure the sessions are delivered in accordance with EN Safeguarding Policy
