

Step 1: Visit <u>www.sportenglandclubmatters.com</u> and click 'Login' on the top right hand corner. On the following page, click 'Create new account'.

Step 2: Enter your personal details. Your email address will become your user name and is required to allow us to verify your account. Please read the declaration and either tick or leave the boxes blank depending on your preference, and complete the 'how did you hear about us' question.



Step 3: Enter your CSP from the drop down menu. Then start typing the name of your club in the second box. Select your club from the club drop down menu.


If you are not part of a club you will be able to complete your registration by clicking the box to indicate you are not a club member. Again, if you are involved with a club, we would recommend linking yourself to a club while you register, as this log in option does not give you full access to all the resources.



Step 4: Please read our data protection statement and if you understand and agree tick the box.



You will then have to tick the 'I'm not a robot' box. This will open a window that will ask you to select all the images that contain a certain object, such as street signs. When you have completed this task click verify, this box will close and you will be able to then click register my account.



Step 5: A verification email will be sent to your address with a link asking you to confirm your account. Once you have done this – your account is ready for you to start using!

ii) Alternatively, you can find them by selecting the 'Club People' option from the drop down box.



Step 8: Once you have found the workshop you want to attend, click on the 'i' the icon shown here to sign up to the workshop




Step 9: Use the below drop down box to confirm how you would like to be notified of the workshop. The different options are:
