Everyone gathered round to watch Chloe's wizardry on court and for 7 minutes, she didn't have cancer.

Huge congratulations to the eventual winners Ashby Stars and runners up, Nottinghamshire Sirens Cops. Thank you to everyone that played, umpired, spent money and supported us. Thank you to the Players NC Committee for all their hard work to make the tournament a success and to all the Players girls for their dedication to raising our biggest total to date.

£7810 will be donated to Pancreatic Cancer UK, in Chloe's name and £1000 will be given to Chloe so she can tick a few more things off her bucket list.

However her involvement in sport took a little trip down under where she was recently selected to take part in the World Transplant Games in Perth, Australia in April 2023 to compete in the 5km road race and golf for the GB and Northern Ireland. With some fundraising,



and the amazing support of Towcester Walking netball and Towcestrian Kites netball Club, she was able to get to the games! Denise returned home with a 3 Gold medals breaking the fastest time in her age group for the 5k Road Race and the GB & NI ladies team also won the team gold medal. But this wasn't the last of the bling with Denise and her team mate being the only female team in the Golf competition and achieved yet another 1st place!
